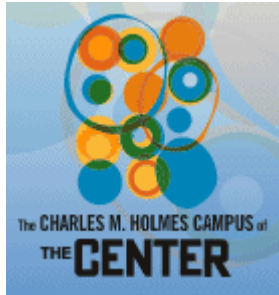

Detail: *The Boys of Original Plumbing: Past, Present & Future* is a photography exhibit by Amos Mac, founder and photographer behind "Original Plumbing magazine", the Trans Male Quarterly. Taken in the past year, all of the models are female-to-male (FTM) transgender identified, and shows the diversity of the FTM community in size, age, body, as well as hormone use and non-use. Many of the models have shown up on already on the pages of Original Plumbing magazine, while some will appear in the future. Exhibit will be on display during Center operating hours: noon to 10:00pm, Monday through Thursday, noon to 6:00pm on Fridays and 9:00am to 6:00pm on Saturdays. The Center is closed on Sundays.
